SERMON TITLE Pastor At Boshoff: Just who do you think you are? DATE 26 APRIL 2017

WELCOME Ask each person in the group to give a short testimony of how God got them out of an impossible situation.

WORSHIP Sing 1x praise and 2x worship songs. Prayer time – focus on setting your mind on God's promises!

WORD

DECLARE: "I know who I am in Christ!"

Victory lies within our thoughts about us!

When there is an attack on your life, your thoughts about yourself and the way you see yourself will determine your victory.

QUESTION: Why is your identity about yourself so powerful?

Read: Proverbs 23:7 & 3 John 1:2

REMEMBER – Your circumstances do not determine your identity, instead you should set your mind on who Christ says you are! **Read: Colossians 3:1-3**

HOW TO SET YOUR MIND ON WHO CHRIST SAYS YOU ARE:

1. Set your mind on things above! **Read: 2 Corinthians:16-17**

- Think eagle thoughts. Think Christ thoughts!
- You have a new identity. A new life. Hidden in Christ!
- Stop thinking like the old man. A turkey. Renew your mind to think the thoughts of the new man. An eagle!
- Stop looking at where you have been and start looking at where you can be!

Read: Philippians 3:3-8

QUESTION: What does it mean to have confidence in Christ and not in the flesh?

Focus:

- I am no longer a sinner, but righteous.
- I am no longer inferior, but confident in Him.
- I am no longer an "I can't" person, but an "I can" person.

Read: Romans 12:2

QUESTION: How do you renew your mind?

- Stop thinking like the world.
- Stop thinking turkey thoughts.
- Stop Identifying with your emotions and feelings.

Read: Numbers 13:26-33

QUESTION: Why did only two go into the Promised Land and the other 10 not?

- The 10 focused on the giants, two focused on God's promises.
- The 10 thought they were not able but the two thought they were well able.

YOU BETTER BELIEVE YOUR THOUGHTS AND YOUR WORDS ARE DECIDING YOUR FUTURE!

Read: Numbers 14:20-30

QUESTION: Concluding thoughts, why would you go into the land that God has promised to you?

The Bible is clear – Israel perished in the wilderness because of a grasshopper mentality – a slave mentality. We can thus choose in the wilderness if we want to think like a turkey or like an eagle (a child of God).

BIBLE SCHOOL

In Module 1 – Fellowship with God – you will learn how to: Hear God's voice, pray, understand the Bible, and Dwell in God's presence.
