WELCOME Allow members to connect with each other before you start with Praise and Worship

WORSHIP Sing 1x praise and 1x worship song

WORD

LAST WEEK WE DISCOVERED THAT WHILE WE WAIT FOR GOD'S PROMISES TO BECOME A REALITY, WE SHOULD SOW THE RIGHT SEEDS.

Ask some homecell members to read the following scriptures:

Galatians 6:9; Ecclesiastes 11:6

QUESTION 1: Last week we heard that we should sow the right seed during this "waiting time." How did you apply this in your personal life during the past week? (Allow several members to share their experiences.)

QUESTION 2: How important is our attitude during this "waiting time?"

Answer: Our attitude will have a huge impact on how we will be sustained during this time.

WE MUST TURN OUR "WAITING ROOM" INTO A "WORSHIP ROOM!!" WE NEED TO WORSHIP GOD WHILE WE WAIT FOR OUR DELIVERANCE!!

Ask a cell member to read the following scripture: **Psalms 27:1-14**

QUESTION 3: It is believed that David wrote this Psalm just before he became king. During this time he experienced many personal challenges and battles as well as persecution from his enemies. What are some of the things that stand out for you in this Psalm?

Answer:

1. Even in the face of persecution and war David placed his hope, faith and trust in God.
2. David knew that running into the presence of God was his only hope.
3. David decided to turn his "waiting room" into a "worship room." He decided to worship God in the midst of his situation.
4. David never lost hope of God's intended outcome for his life.

Philippians 4:6, 7 (MSG)

6-7 Don't fret or worry. Instead of worrying, pray. Let petitions and praises shape your worries into prayers, letting God know your concerns. Before you know it, a sense of God's wholeness, everything coming together for good, will come and settle you down. It's wonderful what happens when Christ displaces worry at the centre of your life.

Let's see how some of the people in the Bible applied this principle in their own lives. (Ask several of your homecell members to find and read the following scriptures at the appropriate times.)

- 1. HABAKKUK: when Habakkuk became depressed because he didn't think God was acting quickly enough, God said to him: Read Habakkuk 2:2, 3. Look at Habakkuk's response: Habakkuk 3:17-19**
- 2. DAVID: Psalms 42:11**
- 3. JONAH: Jonah 2:9, 10**
- 4. PAUL & SILAS: Acts 16:25, 26**

QUESTION 4: Why is it so important for us to cultivate a spirit of worship in our "waiting room?"

Answer:

1. Worship gives us heaven's perspective!!! When praise goes up, heaven comes down!!! (Psalms 34:1)
2. Worship strengthens and settles your heart during the wait. (Isaiah 40:31)
3. Worship causes His peace to come and settle upon you. (John 14:27; Philippians 4:6, 7)
